## §1 General provisions

1. These regulations (hereinafter referred to as the "Regulations") are issued by the organizer of the Festival, the “Lux Pro Monumentis” Foundation.

2. Whenever the Regulations refer to:

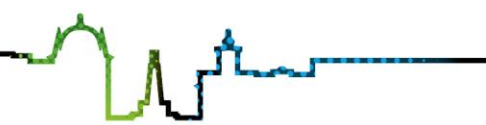
- a. “event” - this shall mean any events taking place as part of the "Kinetic Light Art Festival" Light.Move.Festival - 2025, in accordance with its artistic program.
- b. “security services” - this shall mean persons appointed by the organizer, including employees of security and property protection agencies, who carry an ID issued by the organizer, responsible for ensuring the safety of participants at the event.



- c. “information services” - this shall mean persons, including volunteers, appointed by the organizer to provide all information regarding the event and organizational arrangements, carrying an ID issued by the organizer.
  - d. “event area” – this shall mean the previously mentioned locations within the city of Łódź, separated by large distances and allowing for social distancing.
3. The Regulations are addressed to all persons participating in the event. Every person taking part in the event is obliged to comply with the provisions of the Regulations.
  4. The purpose of the Regulations is to ensure safety during the event by defining the rules of conduct for persons present at the event and their use of the area where the event is held.

## **§2 Rights and obligations of the organizer and event participants**

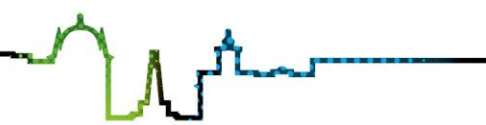
1. The organizer is responsible for the safety of people present at the event and for maintaining order during the event, including:
  - a. security services and information services
  - b. by appointing a safety coordinator responsible for supervising security services and organizing their work
  - c. providing medical assistance
2. The organizer may record the course of the event for documentation, promotional, or advertising purposes in future years. The image of people present at the event area may be recorded and subsequently disseminated for documentation, reporting, advertising, and promotional purposes.
3. With regard to fire safety, the organizer ensures that:
  - a. service staff, security, and information personnel will be familiarized with the location of portable fire-fighting equipment and hydrants, as well as the procedures to follow in the event of a fire.
  - b. Security personnel will be trained to conduct evacuations, alert the fire brigade, use portable fire-fighting equipment, and provide first aid, with training provided by a specialized security and property protection agency.
4. Event participants are obliged to behave in a manner that does not endanger other participants.
5. The following are prohibited during the event:
  - a. weapons and other dangerous objects
  - b. explosive materials



- c. pyrotechnic products
  - d. flammable materials
  - e. narcotic drugs or psychotropic substances
6. Furthermore, it is prohibited to:
- a. Entering and staying without authorization in areas designated for artists and event staff.
  - b. Throwing objects toward the stage and other areas used by artists and event staff, as well as toward other people working at the event.
  - c. Starting a fire.
  - d. Blocking emergency exits.
  - e. Climbing trees and poles on the event premises.
7. Participants of LMF are required to comply with the instructions and orders of the police, security services, and the organizer, as well as to observe fire safety regulations.
8. Event participants are obliged to respect the property of other participants, the artists' equipment, all other devices and technical installations, as well as any property owned by or placed on site by the organizer.
9. All problems and inquiries regarding the course of the event should be reported to security, event staff, or information services identified by badges, or to the organizer: Łódź, 86 Piotrkowska Street, unit 10u.
10. In the event of an accident, fainting, or other health issues, you should report to event staff or go directly to the medical services on duty at the event site.
11. Individuals who pose a direct threat to human health or life, as well as to protected property, will be detained and immediately handed over to the police.

### **§3 organizational and order rules**

1. The organizer's security services are authorized to:
  - a. Issuing order-related instructions to individuals disrupting public order or behaving in violation of the regulations, and in the event of non-compliance with these instructions, ordering them to leave the event area.
  - b. Apprehension and detention for the purpose of immediately handing over to the police individuals posing a threat to the orderly conduct of the event, as well as a direct threat to human life and health, and to protected property.
  
2. Order maintenance services are obliged to:
  - a. Ensure the safety of the festival infrastructure, i.e., technical equipment and installations within the event area.



- b. Remove from the event area or hand over to the police individuals whose behavior disrupts public order or violates the regulations.
3. The organizer's security services will not use any prohibited technical means of coercion against event participants. All actions undertaken by them should be carried out with respect for the dignity and other personal rights of the individuals concerned.
4. If the actions taken by the organizer's security services prove ineffective, the organizer or the safety coordinator, on behalf of the organizer, requests assistance from the police, confirming this by submitting a written notification.
5. In the event of police intervention, the event organizer's security staff shall follow the instructions issued by the police.
6. The security services will be equipped with communication devices: two-way radios and mobile phones. The police officer responsible for securing the event on behalf of the police will have direct communication with the person responsible for the organizer's security services.
